Ettore Recchi is professor of sociology at Sciences Po Paris, where he is a member of the Observatoire Sociologique du Changement (OSC) and Director of the MA and PhD programs in Sociology. He is also part-time professor at the Migration Policy Center (MPC) of the European University Institute in Florence, where he coordinates the Global Mobilities Project (<http://www.migrationpolicycentre.eu/globalmobilities/>).

His main research foci are mobility (in its different forms), social stratification, and European integration. A methodologically versatile sociologist especially committed to comparative research, Recchi's last book is *Everyday Europe: Social Transnationalism in an Unsettled Continent* (Policy Press, 2019), a co-authored volume with all participants in a six-country project that he directed (the EUCROSS project: www.eucross.eu).
